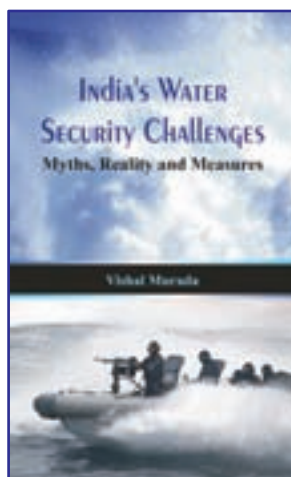
About the Book

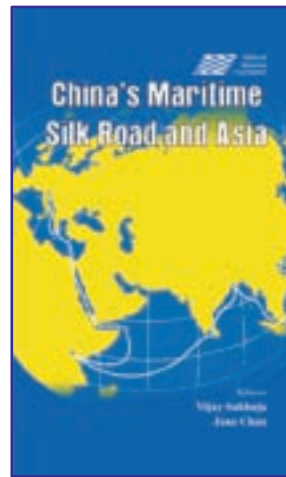
About the Book

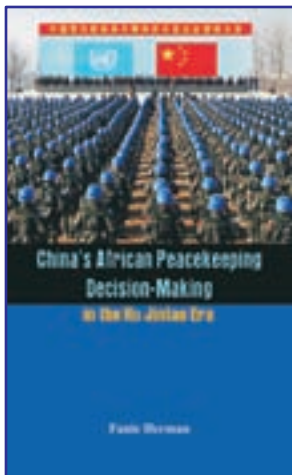

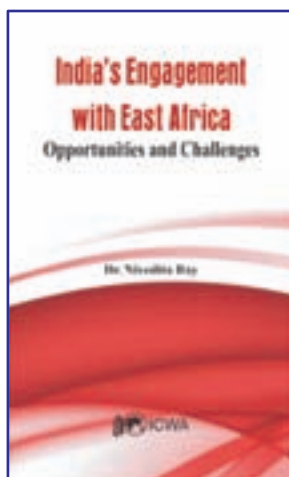
The present book is based on field study of Nepal-India open border arrangement and conduct of such unique and free border existing between the two countries since the signing of Sugauli Treaty in 1815-16. Its openness poses both challenges and opportunities for disturbing as well as making bilateral relations smooth and friendly. How such close relations which are incomparable to others have been managed and how the newer problems that arise with the pace of time and situation are being addressed are also the theme of study.

The findings of study are no less significant as Nepal and India have developed mechanisms to deal with the day-to-day problems making significant improvements for streamlining the border. Yet, two types of problems have given rise to occasional controversy: infringement of border and humanitarian problems caused by the erosion of borderland and occupation of no-man's land by both Indian and Nepalis. The use and misuse of open border by elements indulged in illegal trade, criminal activities of all nature, have also made border management more complex. The Revolution 1979 replaced monarchy with clerics-rule and religion coalesced with politics. A new political culture emerged under influence of religion that swayed political process. The emergence of a new political culture in the post-Shah period influenced political process which gave birth to a new political system. Ayatollah Khomeini became the Velayat-e Faqih (Supreme Leader) in the post-Shah period since he led the revolution. The concept of Velayat-e Faqih is derived from the Imamate system. The Velayat-e Faqih is the most powerful and dominant institution in Iran and whole Iranian system revolve around it, and all institutions derive their legitimacy from it. Iran's society is transformed along Islamic line and major changes are introduced in social aspects. Educational system and women affairs have received major changes, and restrictions are enhanced over mass-media and social activities. Iran's economy has also come under religious influence and witnessed creation of the Islamic banks and other institutions to manage Iranian economy. It is noteworthy that leaders and political forces were divided over policy issues in the post-Revolution Iran which still continue. The Revolution 1979 has left indelible impression on Iran's society, polity, and economy and Islam will remain as an ideology in determining the country's behaviour despite divisions within political forces.

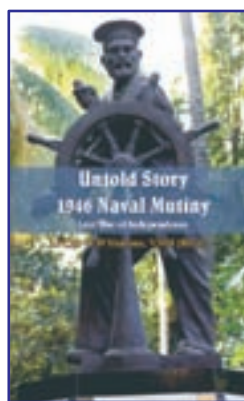
It was not that he was without ambition, he wished to command at the highest levels, he was trained for the task, and he was an excellent soldier.

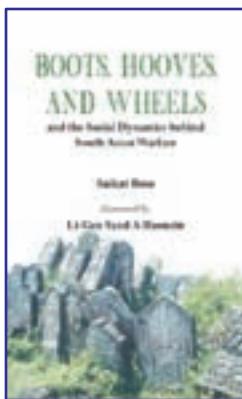

A number of books have been written on the 1946 Royal Indian Navy Mutiny but the true story of this historic event remains untold with few facts deliberately suppressed. The Inquiry Commission report gave graphic details of mutinous acts at all the naval stations but it awarded no punishment to the guilty. It glossed over the bad conditions of service leading to the mutiny. It recommended no action against naval administration although bad service conditions were stated to be the root cause of mutiny in the Navy. It was an irony of British Naval Justice that the men voicing these bad service conditions were punished under the Naval Discipline Act. This book attempts to bring out a concise version of the composition and administration of the Navy including its sudden expansion during the World War II.

The author's long association with naval counter intelligence has helped him to discern some unknown facts of this mutiny which are reflected in this book. Without him the history of Indian mountaineering would have been quite different. Col Narinder Kumar was born on 8 Dec 1933, at Rawalpindi, now in Pakistan. He was commissioned in 1954 in the Kumaon Regiment. His mountaineering career started in 1958, as the expedition leader to Trishul. He reached 28,300 feet on Everest in 1960, when only one Indian – Tenzing Norgay and seven other mountaineers in the whole world had climbed higher. He was the Deputy Leader of the record breaking Indian Everest Expedition in 1965, which put nine climbers on the top. Out of the 13 highest Indian Himalayan peaks above 24,000 feet, including Nanda Devi, 9 were climbed under his leadership. Surprisingly, he did all this after having lost his toes to frostbite, and the doctors had declared him unfit for climbing, as well as for going higher than 7,000 feet! ‘Bull’, as Colonel Kumar is affectionately known, even led an Indo German Indus Boat Expedition and Trishul Ski Expedition.

In 1978 and in 1981, he led a daring high altitude reconnaissance to the Siachen Glacier, traversing it from its snout to its source at Indira Col. He personally led the summit team to the 24,300 ft high Sia Kangri. His team went up to Saltoro Kangri (25,400 feet) and Teram Kangri II (24,300 feet). And as a farewell gift to his regiment, the Kumaoni’s, he led a regimental expedition to Kamet, (25,447 ft) in 1983, just before his retirement.

Col N N Bhatia was commissioned in the Kumaon regiment and commanded 2 Kumaon (Berar) – one of the oldest Indian Army Battalions. He took part in the 1965 and 1971 wars, and during the insurgencies in Mizoram, Nagaland, Punjab and Jammu & Kashmir. His numerous articles have been published in various journals and in a Pakistani newspaper “The Lahore Times”. He is involved in trying to obtain the release of 54 Indian POW’s languishing in Pakistani jails since 1971 war.

About Omraam Mikhael Aivanhov

In the 16th century Nostradamus wrote the following in one of his prophecies:

"In a poor family a child with blonde hair will be born From a Balkan country this eagle will fly And settle in the land of the Rooster His name is the same as mine and the world will remember him for a long time His voice will be heard by people on earth And it will be followed by departure and disaster And a new time will come."

Mikhael Aivanhov was born to a poor family in Bulgaria in the year of 1900. His father died when Mikhael was quite young and he was raised by his mother. She was a deeply religious and spiritual person. After having completed his apprenticeship with his spiritual master Peter Deunov and eight to ten years of university studies, Aivanhov became a professor of psychology and philosophy.

He moved to France where he lived until his death in 1986. Even though he had his base in France, Aivanhov travelled extensively. His trip to India in 1959 was particularly remarkable. There he met with prominent masters of yoga such as Neem Kaaroli Baba, who gave him the name of Om-Ram (the two sacred hindu words), the female yogi Ananda Mayi Ma and Swami Sivananda. He also met Swami Nityananda, guru of the famous Muktananda. At this meeting the Swami was sitting surrounded by his disciples and when he saw Aivanhov, he went into a long and deep meditation. Opening his eyes again he said to Aivanhov, in perfect English:

"A pure heart, peace in your soul and all powers are given to you".

Afterwards, Nityananda spoke the name of an old Indian sage and explained that Aivanhov was his incarnation. Probably the most important meeting Aivanhov had in India was with the legendary Babajii whom they say is more than 500 years old and lives in seclusion in the Himalayas. Many people try to find Babajii, but he only shows himself to those who are ready for a meeting with him. Aivanhov spent several days in Babajii's company. What happened between them is unknown.
